Located in southwest Oakland County, the Village of Milford is nestled in the hills of the Huron River valley, surrounded by a ribbon of regional parks, including Kensington MetroPark, Proud Lake State Park, Highland Recreation Area and Camp Dearborn. The recently completed Milford Trail links downtown to miles of scenic open space and panoramic vistas. Horseback riding, canoeing, skiing and other water sports are well within reach, providing many opportunities to enjoy the outdoors.

The must-see in Milford is the charismatic, traditional downtown, established just before the turn of the century, but renovated to an Old World style. Acting as a modern town square, it serves as the community's meeting place amid stately nineteenth-century architecture and accents of colorful landscaping. The downtown is surrounded by serene, yet spirited neighborhoods, reflecting many eras and styles, and both are listed on the National Register of Historic Places.

Visitors will find friendly merchants presiding over familiar retail markets and Milford-exclusive destinations. Stop over for an afternoon or a weekend, and check out the specialty boutiques and restaurants located in and around Main Street, including family-friendly cafes, cutting-edge clothiers and craft stores, galleries and award-winning gourmet dining. From diamonds to delicacies, you'll find everything you covet and crave in Milford!

Milford is a great place to raise a family, with a newly built YMCA and Library; the Huron Valley School system; hometown parades and events; and numerous arts and cultural amenities. Come downtown for the Summer Concert Series, Art in the Park, Ladies Night Out, and Shop, Rock and Stroll. And don't miss the regionally acclaimed Milford Memories Summer Festival, always held the second weekend in August.
